FINANCIALLY SPEAKING

Finance Committee members (Susan Lambert, Carol Peecksen, Bern O'Brien, Lucy Hightower and Pastor Steve) thank you for your faithful giving to God's work through St. Paul's ministries.

Points to share at this time include the following:

- 1) As of August 31st we spent \$171,664 which is \$3206 less than the \$174,870 budgeted.
- 2) As of July 31st, we are \$12,945 behind anticipated income (\$160,595 actual vs. \$173,540 budgeted).

Church Council gave Treasurer Carol Peecksen permission to transfer \$10,000 from reserves to our checking account to cover the income shortfall. Our Finance Committee and staff continue to look for ways to be frugal with expenses. We'll keep you up to date as the summer progresses.
